

**POST-OFFICE ROBBERIES.**—The Post-Office and Store of H. A. Bidwell, Esq., at North Becket, was broken into on Sunday night week, and robbed of Postage Stamps to the amount of about \$150—some change—and various articles from the Store; Boots, Vestings, Silks, &c. None of the letters remaining in the Office are believed to have been taken or rifled.

On Saturday night last the Post-Office at Worthington was entered and robbed of Postage Stamps, and the store of N. Bates & Son, in which the Office is kept, of a quantity of goods, and a small amount of cash. A man named Goldthwaite of Hinsdale, and McCoy of Troy, were arrested at Hinsdale on Sunday, having been traced from Worthington by tracks in the light snow which fell on Saturday night. Goods recognized as belonging to the Messrs. Bates and to Mr. Bidwell were found in their possession, and also a bag of burglar's tools. An examination of the persons was commenced at Worthington on Tuesday.
