The purpose of the Worthington Historical Society is to identify, select, gather, preserve, maintain, catalogue and make accessible historical documents and significant memorabilia from the Town of Worthington, Massachusetts, to include church, library, government and family history.

The purpose is also to stimulate and perpetuate interest in and appreciation for the history of the Town of Worthington.

Prepare a construction estimate for the design and construction of a storage vault.

Determine possible sources of funding. Sources could include church, library, FSB, State Library Commissioners.
