Sam Beck - house built 1780 now lived in by David H. Powers

Lake Boney - <sup>in</sup> pasture of Ira Jones

David Brunson same place - were first millers in town

Samuel Towler - few rods east of old church near Watts

Ruben Adams - second saw & grist mill  
on site of Cole & Hayden Mills

Samuel Pettengill - where H. Scott now owns

Nehemiah Prouty - present place of Henry Tower

Elizee Tenker - homestead the residence of Nathan Jackson

William Ward - daughter, Mrs Chauncey D. Riving
