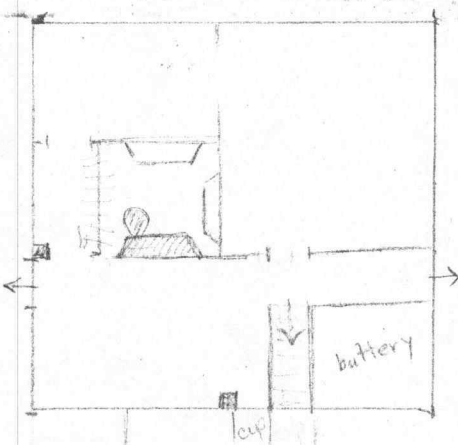

We the Subscribers being appointed by the Hon^{ble} Judge of Probate for said County to set off to Mrs Sarah Huntington Widow & Relict of the Rev^d Jonathan Huntington late of said Town deceased her right of Dower in the Real Estate of her said Husband deceased. Having undertaken, attended to said Business, Report as follows: viz^t That she the said Sarah have the full and free use of one third part of the Cellar under the dwelling at the east end of the Cellar with the pee up of the Cellar stairs and a passage through the other part of the Cellar. Also the middle room in said House with the room at the South east corner of the House and the passage leading to said room. Also one third of the Buttery with all liberty of freely passing and repassing to and from the same. Also the stairs in the Great House leading into the Chambers & the chamber directly over the middle room and the chamber over the northeast room & the entry leading from the one to the other. Also the up of one third of the Kitchen Chamber on the north side of the same & a right freely to pass to and from it out of the Chamber over the middle room. And it is referred to the Heirs of said deceased that they have full and free liberty and right to pass through any room belonging to the said Sarah in order to enter into any room belonging to them without going out of the outer Doors of the House.
