friends i received your kind messag last saturday and was glad to hear from dear friends it gave me much joy to hear from you once more and to think we can Chat together altho we cannot se each other yours found us all well and i hope these lines will find you the same it is a general time of health here we hav had a very open winter not snow enough to go out of town we hav had a great deal of rain and mud & suppose you hav had good sleighing this long time by accounts we hav from that state & never have seen such hard winters since we left that state as we go to have there & shold like to visit that country once more but i never expect to as we hav got so old you wanted to no my age i shal be 64 if i shold live ^{to the first day of june} iouah will be 66 next October my Children have all gon from me are all mared but one he is in Iowa on his farm of ninty five acres he is a living near his Uncles on his fathers side Cowill lives in Wisconsin James lives two miles from us has a good farm Jilda lives in Cattaraugus Co New York Mariah lives in Wisconsin she mared a man by the name of Henry Harvey tha live in Kialising Great ^{Wisconsin} Cllnear the missippa Orville lives in Leon Monroe Co Jane lives in Wellington Mary lives in Indiana Amarella is at home now i expect tha will leave soon she mared a man by the name of Lewis Norton she has one Child about five years old he is a smart one i heard from Dickersons last week tha was all well she has but one Child at hom i heard from Wellington a weak ags tha was quite smart Brother Roswell had a very sever spell of the Rheumatis last fall it came very near yousing him up but i hear that he can get around with a cane James Spelman was smart i visited with him last spring he was very smart i did not see Aunt Lovisa moved out there that winter ~~she~~ Roswell was at your hous she is quite smart gets som homesick tha are a making there hav bin to meting to day heard a first rate sermon the meting hours is about twenty rods from our hous we have meting about every sunday it is rather dul times here as to religeon i believe that i hav hit all tht will be interesting to you i want you shold pres it on your childrens minds if it is so that you cannot writ to have them write to me so that
