My Dear but not forgetterant

as I have a few leisure moments to spare and as I have thought of you  
more or less this week & finally concluded to write a letter to you thinking  
that I shall get one in return it is a long time since I have held any  
communication with a dear aunt by writing we are all well and are  
enjoying innumerable blessings and hope these lines will find you and  
family enjoying the same one thing that has made me think of you  
so much is because Aunt Lois Mody is here with me Julia has gone  
on a visit to see her children and tha got me to take care of her and  
I esteem it a great privilege she is quite smart she can walk around  
the house and I think as sensible as ever now but cannot do any work  
she dont seem to have the use of her hands to work but that is no  
matter I think she has done her part all I wish is that she can be comfortable  
the few remaining days she has to stay she says you wished to know where her  
boys was Jra has gone to Illinois and was all well when tha last heard from him  
and was doing well Ethan has gone to Michigan and so you see Aunt is left  
with Julia & Ethan has bin gone about six years Aunt was taken <sup>(engaged)</sup> sicker  
that winter and continued so until about a year ago she was a good deal of  
trouble there was a good while that tha had to keep her confined  
for fear that she wold stray away but now she seems to have her senses  
perfectly well but her nerves appear to be weak she appears to be  
contented here she gets to worrying about Julia's youngest boy but stalk to  
her and she soon gets over it and says she will not worry about him for  
she knows she cant tak care of him I believe I have writ all that is necessary  
I wish that you cold com and see her it wold do her somuch good I will  
tell you about our friends at Wellington tha are all well there I will  
tell you about Uncle James family as far as I know I do not know but  
that you have heard from them of late ~~they~~ a year ago last winter  
tha lost their youngest son he die very sudden with the fever last winter  
tha lost their second daughter Mary Sluckison she left two children  
Uncle and aunt was aliving with them what tha do now I hav not heard  
whether tha stay there or hav gon to live with their youngest daughter  
Mr Sluckison is maried again Marys death was a heavy loss to them for  
tha intended to live with them while tha lived but you see the young  
will be taken and the old left we cannot order things it is the hand  
of the Lord that orders all things I think that shewre writ all that I  
know of

Now I will give you a little sketch of my family although we do not now as it will be very interesting we live here in Copley alone not a child with me only when tha com to make me a visit I have eight Children of three boys and five girls my two oldest boys Orville and James live close by me and my oldest girl Julia the next Mariah she has gone to Wisconsin this Spring she has three Children the oldest is 13 Mary ~~has~~ lives in Indiana she has bin gone this 12 years she has seven Children Jane lives in Wellington she has bin married this eight years she has no Children Ransom is not married he was one and twenty last Nov he lives with James this summer Amarell lives in Ohio about eighty miles from here she is married is about twenty ~~and~~ and so you see tha are scattered all over the world sometimes it does not seem possible that a family of Children could be separated from home and each other but it is so i did not tell you how many Children the three oldest have Chas fore Jhas two Julia has fore I think sometimes it is rather hard to raise such a family and then be left a lone but we are both able to earn our living as yet we have a little lame and plenty of work we held the post office until we got peasest he holds the post of the peace offis that helps som as he is not able to do a large day work I think that we have writ enou more than you will want to read and so i will draw to a close should be very much pleased if you wold answer this soon for i should like to get alone before autent went hom it wold do her so much good & thin she will be here som <sup>the</sup> weeks longer to Sally Stevens

I forgot to tell you that my youngest sister lays dangerous with a cancer or scrofular which is very bad it is on her stomach it has eat about half of one breast of and has got clear across to the other I went to see her last week do not think that I ever shall see her again it is about forty miles from here she has two children in she seems quite resived it is Lucinda she married <sup>to</sup> aman by the name of Green

aunt I sends her best respects to you give mine to all inquiring friends
