

MINIATURE WRENCHES ARE SLIM AND STURDY

Most miniature wrenches are either thick and clumsy or are flimsy stampings from thin sheet metal. These fine sets are just right. Heads are only 3/2" to ½" thick, depending on size. Heads are smaller, too, for tight spots.

Yet they meet industry and government standards.
Forged of alloy steel. Heads coined and broached accurately to size, and polished. Bright chrome plated.

Sizes fit fastenings in carburetors, electrical systems, appliances, small mechanisms. Each size marked. About 31/4" to 4" long. 15°-60° heads.

Excellent for all knives, chisels, other edge tools that work best, are safest, when dead sharp.



Red side, rouge-impregnated, hones, sharpens gently, without tearing the metal. Black side for finishing — polishes the edge till it will shave close

and clean. Use dry — no mess.

About 12" long. Finely finished beechwood handle. Leather facings about 8" x 11/2".

SCULPTORS' RASP-FILES **EVEN CUT STONE**

Sculptors' wood file-rasps tough enough to cut marble and other "soft" stone! Made of genuine A-1 file steel as used in industrial metal-cutting files. Scientifically heat treated for best wear resistance.

Complete set of six versatile shapes. Essential for shaping wood, plaster, plastics, marble and like materials in sculpture, wood carving, pattern making, cabinet work. Each is rasp cut on one end for roughing, file cut on the other for smoothing. Hard-to-find feature: both ends same shape for smoothing without risk of changing contours created with rasp end.

Fast cutting because teeth are properly cut and spaced. About 8" long. Cutting lengths about 2". Center handle portion about \(^{1}/4\)" square, rounded for comfort.

PARALLEL-ACTION PLIERS HOLD BETTER


These powerful flat-nose pliers grip better than ordinary pliers because jaws are always parallel. They grip like a vise, hold like a wrench.

Excellent also for bending and shaping sheet metal, flat stock, etc.

Hardened, serrated jaws to avoid slipping. Longitudinal V-groove in jaws holds wires, pins, other round items. Open throat for passage of long pieces.


BENCH BLOCK **DOES** MANY JOBS

Hardened steel for lifetime use. Hex shape allows use in a vise, or on edge as anvil.

Top surface smoothly ground flat for exacting work. 15 closely graduated holes go clear thru, range from .040" (1 mm.) to ½" (6.35 mm.) dia. Fit practically any size punch, pin, or rivet. One fits watchmakers staking stumps.

4 milled slots (.020" to .040" wide) do many bending, holding, punching and forming jobs. About 11/8" across points x 11/16" thick.

LONG CHAIN NOSE PLIERS BENT FOR ROUND-THE-CORNER WORK

These fine, problem-solving pliers would be over 7'' long if left straight. They are about $5\frac{1}{4}$ " long to the bend, and the jaws extend $1\frac{1}{4}$ ", practically at right angles.

Rugged jaws are each $\frac{5}{16}$ " wide x $\frac{1}{4}$ " thick at joint, tapered to about $\frac{1}{16}$ " x $\frac{1}{16}$ " at tips, to get into small places. Finely serrated about 1" back from

tips, otherwise smooth. Smooth acting box joint for permanent jaw alignment, freedom from looseness. Full polish finish. Very nicely made.

MINIATURE WIRE CUTTERS COME IN FINE AND ULTRA-FINE QUALITY

These miniature wire cutters cut soft wire flush, leaving no wire peak. This requires fine, sharp, handhoned cutting edges.

Excellent for miniature electronics, instruments, work on vacuum tubes, miniature lamps, etc. Light weight reduces operator fatigue from exacting wire cutting

Available in two styles: End cutter at 90° to handles, or cutters angled at about 70° with one

end coming to fine point for maximum get-in ability.

Difference between the two qualities is in cutting ability. The ultra-fine quality is made of superior and more costly tool steel for longer life in production use, and there is more hand work in shaping and honing the cutting edges. Otherwise the two qualities are essentially equal.

Finely ground finish all over. About 41/4" long. Jaws
