

WORTHINGTON LANDMARK, an 11-room house built in 1780, has been acquired by Mr. and Mrs. Joseph O. Hebert Jr. of Florence. Mr. Hebert heads the Gazette Printing Co. of Northampton. Former resident of the house is George W. Humphrey, indicted in September on a charge of counterfeiting in the cellar of the house. Extensively remodeled in 1951, the house has such features as eight fireplaces and a 30-by-30 living room.
